What are InitiaLit Readers?

MultiLit has developed four sets of 60 phonic readers for children who are just learning to read. These delightful decodable books are carefully sequenced to encourage children to use good reading strategies from the start.

Children who love adventure, humour, mischievous animals and learning about the world around them will enjoy our beautifully illustrated stories.

The decodable InitiaLit Readers were originally developed to support InitiaLit – a whole-class literacy instruction program for Foundation to Year 2 children, but can also be used independently or alongside other synthetic phonics programs.

InitiaLit Readers Levels 1–9 are designed for children in the Foundation year of school. Series 1 and 2 are parallel series of similar level of difficulty, with some non-fiction texts featured in Series 2.





InitiaLit Readers Levels 10-16 are for Year 1 students, and cover different text types, such as information texts, poems and plays, as well as stories. Series 2, also known as The Wattle Series, is written at an easier level than Series 1. These books feature lower word counts, simpler storylines and comprehension questions, and new vocabulary. The Wattle Series was the winner of the inaugural Decodable Book Series award at the 2022 Speech Pathology Australia Book of the Year awards. It is especially recommended for use alongside MiniLit Sage.

During reading

If an error is made on a decodable word, demonstrate how to sound out the word, then sound out the word together with the child. Finally, ask the child to sound out the word independently. For words that cannot be sounded out by the child, simply supply the word and ask the child to repeat it.

The MultiLit eLibrary

Providing students with decodable readers for home reading practice, as well as in the classroom, will help to supercharge their reading progress.

A subscription to the MultiLit eLibrary provides access to the full collection of InitiaLit Readers online, including Series 1 and Series 2 of Levels 1–9 (for the Foundation year), and Series 1 and Series 2 – The Wattle Series of InitiaLit Readers Levels 10–16.

The MultiLit eLibrary has been designed specifically for use for home reading, but can also be used within the school to supplement print copies of InitiaLit Readers. The eLibrary uses a browser-based platform, so books can be read on desktop computers or mobile devices (including smartphones and tablets).

Subscriptions are offered on a fixed price basis for the school year, and will remain active until 31 January of the year following purchase (e.g., the 2023 subscription will expire on 31 January 2024). If your school requires additional accounts during the year, upgrades to the next subscription tier can be made by simply contacting us at library.multilit.com/contact

How it works

- Login to your MultiLit Member account, select a subscription tier and nominate a MultiLit eLibrary administrator for your school. Note: teachers and students count towards your number of users.
- 2. Your MultiLit eLibrary administration account will be created, and login details will be emailed to your administrator (within two business days).
- 3. Your administrator will then be able to upload details of student and teacher users to the system, either individually or by using the CSV spreadsheet template for a bulk upload of users (providing name and email address for each).
- 4. Account details will then be automatically emailed to users, which will allow them to log into the MultiLit eLibrary and start reading! Teachers will need to provide parents and students with direction as to which level is most appropriate for reading practice.
